
Tenant Meeting on Nov 15

Refurb update

The first phase of refurbishment under the **Social Housing Economic Recovery Package** (Sherp) was concluded in June, with 9 units renovated at 25 Mackie St.

The second phase, which will refurbish 10 units at **39 Mackie St**, started in late September.

Two units will be renovated at a time, with tenants moving in and out of "hotel units" throughout the project. We thank them for their patience and collaboration.

Refurbishments will be completed by September 2024. Keep tuned for updates!

The **light green bin** available in all of Connect's blocks of units is for gardening materials only. That includes weeds, garden clippings, small branches, sticks, leaves and flowers

The light green bin is collected every fortnight on the opposite week to the recycling (yellow) bin.
